Indian Institute for Technology Hyderabad (IITH) invites applications for admission to the Ph.D. program in the Department of Liberal Arts.

Areas of specializations

For the January 2026 admissions, we invite applications in the following areas:

- **Economics** (MoE, JRF, RGNF, Other fellowships) - Sub-fields: Monetary policy and Public finance. Applicants should have a 1500-2000 word research proposal ready, as it may need to be submitted at short notice if shortlisted for the interview.
- **English** (MoE, JRF)- Sub-fields: Critical Body Studies, Anglophone Literature, Masculinity Studies. Applicants may keep a 1500 word research (excluding works cited) proposal ready. If shortlisted in the first round, they will have to upload it before the interview.
- **Psychology** (JRF) - Sub-fields: Health Psychology, Social Psychology, Medical Psychology Applicants may keep a 1500 word research proposal ready. If shortlisted in the first round, they will be required to submit it before the interview.

Categories for Admission

1. MoE/Institute Fellowship: This is a full-time program; candidates should not be employed in any organization.
2. CSIR JRF, UGC JRF, DST INSPIRE JRF, DBT JRF, ICMR JRF and similar fellowships from external funding agencies: This is a full-time program; candidates should not be employed in any organization.

Not available in this round of admission: External category for (working professionals with two years of work experience)

Eligibility Criteria for PhD Admission

1. MoE/Institute Fellowship

- 55% marks or equivalent CGPA in the Master's degree in the subject or allied areas.
- In order to obtain the MoE/Institute fellowship, a candidate must have qualified the UGC-NET or GATE or an equivalent qualifying examination.
- Shortlisted candidates must pass an interview conducted by the Department of Liberal Arts, IITH.
- Candidates must also provide evidence of passing the UGC-NET/equivalent qualifying examination.
- Failure to provide final proof of the qualifying degree (Masters degree, etc.) at the time of registration at IIT Hyderabad will lead to the cancellation of the applicant's admission.
- Seat notification for MoE for the current round of admissions: **SC (1), EWS (1)**

2. UGC-JRF or Comparable Fellowship

- 55% marks or equivalent CGPA in the Master's degree in the subject or allied areas.
- Shortlisted candidates must pass an interview conducted by the Department of Liberal Arts.
- Candidates must also provide documentary evidence of qualifying for UGC-JRF/equivalent fellowship.
- Failure to provide final proof of the qualifying degree (Master's degree, etc.) at the time of registration at IIT Hyderabad will lead to cancellation of the applicant's admission.

Procedure for Submitting the Application

- Please fill in and submit the **online application form** available on the Institute website: <https://www.iith.ac.in/>
- **Important Checklist:** (a) Upload certificates from the qualifying exam, UGC-NET or UGC-JRF certificates (or other comparable certificates) (b) Mention the discipline in which you wish to apply (c) Mention the appropriate funding category such as MoE/Institute Fellowship or JRF (d) If applicable, please upload relevant documents pertaining to SC, ST, OBC, EWS and PwD as per Government of India rules

Selection

- Mere fulfillment of the minimum educational qualifications does not necessarily entitle applicants to a call for an interview. The Institute reserves the right to call only the requisite number of PhD candidates based on qualification and suitability.

Fellowship

- Candidates selected under MoE/Institute Fellowship category will obtain monthly fellowships as per IIT Hyderabad norms. Candidates selected under other funding categories will receive fellowships as per the guidelines of those funding agencies.

Reservations

- The reservation of seats in admissions under SC, ST, OBC, EWS categories and for persons with disability (PwD) will be as per Government of India rules.

Other Relevant Information

- Shortlisted candidates will be required to submit a letter of recommendation sent from their teacher/advisor at the educational institution last attended.
- For disciplines which require a research proposal to be submitted: A plagiarism check of the document submitted will be done. The penalty for plagiarism will be immediate disqualification from the selection process.

Tentative dates for the admission process

- List of only shortlisted candidates will be uploaded on the Department of Liberal Arts website by first week of November 2025.
- The interviews will tentatively be scheduled by third week of November 2025.
- The final list of selected candidates for admission into the PhD program will be uploaded on the Department of Liberal Arts website between 27th and 30th November 2025
